M/Y HAG is a 30.8m Custom Line, combining timeless Italian design with a comprehensive 2025 refit that significantly enhances both her technical performance and onboard comfort.

Designed by Zuccon International Project, she features a semi-displacement GRP hull and a well-balanced tri-deck layout, offering smooth cruising and practical living spaces throughout.

Her interiors have been fully refreshed with new furnishings, upgraded finishes, and improved lighting, creating a clean, contemporary atmosphere. The main salon benefits from ample natural light and modern AV systems, offering a comfortable setting for relaxation and socializing.

She accommodates up to 8 - 10 guests in four en-suite cabins, including a full-beam Master suite, a VIP cabin, and two convertible Twin/Double cabins with Pullman berths — ideal for flexible guest arrangements.

Following her extensive 2025 upgrades, including new air conditioning, updated systems, and new water toys, HAG is presented in excellent condition and ready for immediate cruising with a professional crew of six.

MAIN DECK

The main deck of M/Y HAG offers a refined and well-balanced environment, combining contemporary upgrades with the yacht's original Italian design.

The salon has been fully refreshed with new custom furnishings, including a redesigned sofa arrangement, new armchairs, and upgraded finishes throughout. Large windows allow natural light to flow in, enhancing the warm tones of the interior and creating a bright, inviting atmosphere. New electric wooden blinds and updated lighting fixtures add both comfort and functionality, allowing the space to adapt easily from daytime relaxation to evening ambiance.

The dining area is seamlessly integrated within the salon, offering a comfortable and elegant setting for indoor meals, while remaining connected to the main lounge. Upgraded audio-visual systems and discreet smart features enhance the onboard experience without overwhelming the design.

Sliding glass doors open onto the aft deck, where shaded seating and alfresco dining extend the living space outdoors. The connection between interior and exterior areas is fluid and practical, allowing guests to move effortlessly between relaxation, dining, and access to the sea.

LOWER DECK / ACCOMMODATION

The lower deck of M/Y HAG is designed with a strong focus on comfort, functionality, and guest flexibility.

She accommodates up to 8 to 10 guests in four en-suite cabins. The full-beam Master suite offers a spacious and private retreat, featuring a king-size bed, walk-in closet, and a dedicated vanity area. The VIP cabin is equally well-appointed, with a queen-size bed and generous storage, providing a comfortable secondary suite.

The two additional guest cabins are designed for versatility, easily converting between Twin and Double configurations. Each includes a Pullman berth, making them ideal for accommodating families, children, or additional guests without compromising comfort.

Following the 2025 refit, all cabins have been upgraded with new soft furnishings, improved lighting, and refined material finishes. Bathrooms have also been refreshed, with upgraded fittings and detailing, ensuring a consistent and well-maintained standard throughout the accommodation areas.

EXTERIOR

M/Y HAG's exterior spaces are thoughtfully arranged to offer a variety of areas for relaxation, dining, and entertainment throughout the day.

The aft deck provides a comfortable alfresco dining area, directly connected to the salon, making it ideal for casual meals or evening gatherings. Just below, the swim platform offers easy access to the water and serves as a central point for enjoying the yacht's water toys.

The sundeck is one of the yacht's key social areas, featuring generous sunbathing spaces, lounge seating, and a deck Jacuzzi. It offers both open sun and shaded areas, allowing guests to enjoy the space at any time of day.

Forward, the bow area provides an additional, more private lounging space with sunpads, ideal for quiet moments at anchor or while cruising.

Overall, the exterior layout delivers a practical and relaxed onboard lifestyle, combining comfort, privacy, and ease of use across all decks.
